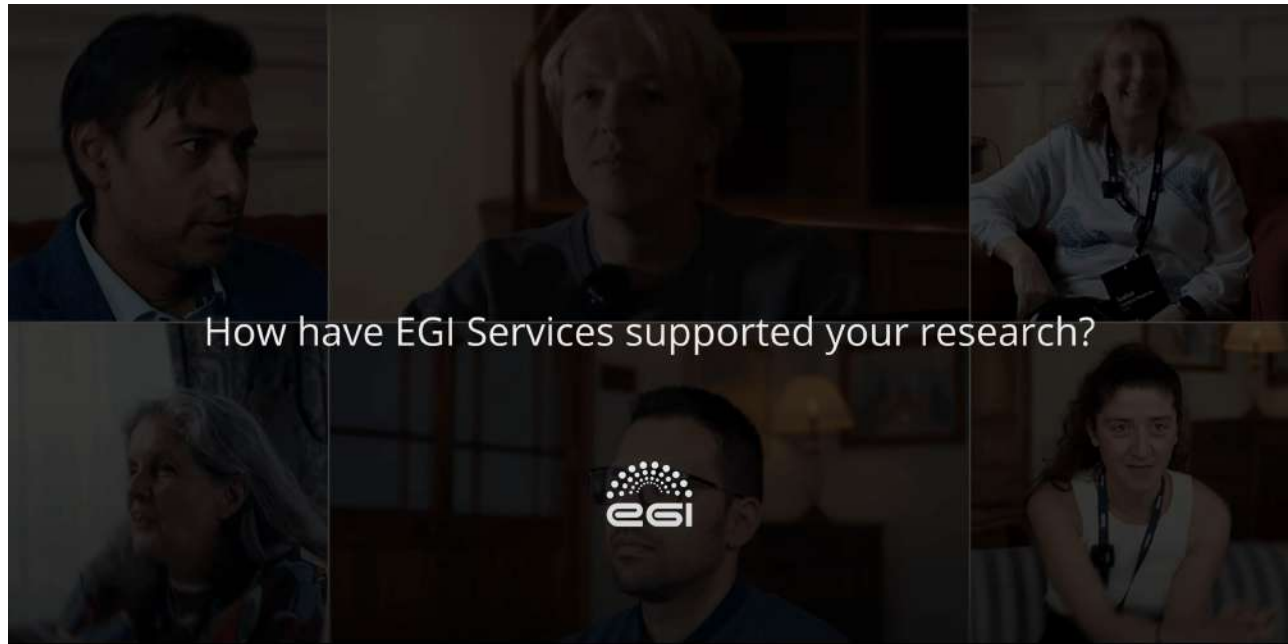




Beyond Borders: EGI Director Tiziana Ferrari on Global Science Partnerships

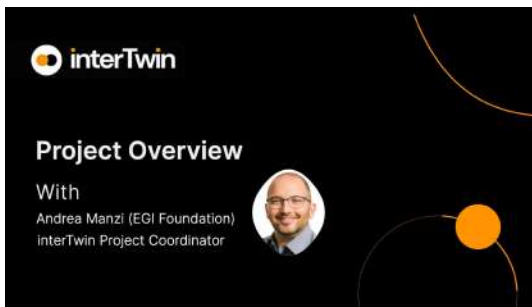

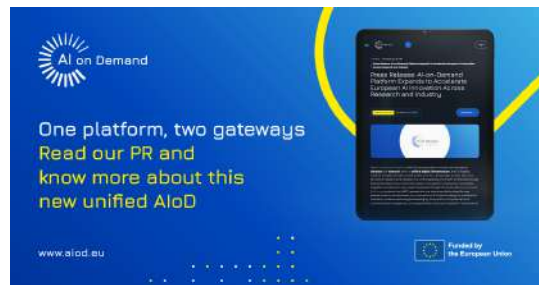
